Stuff that doesn't involve money but meant a lot.

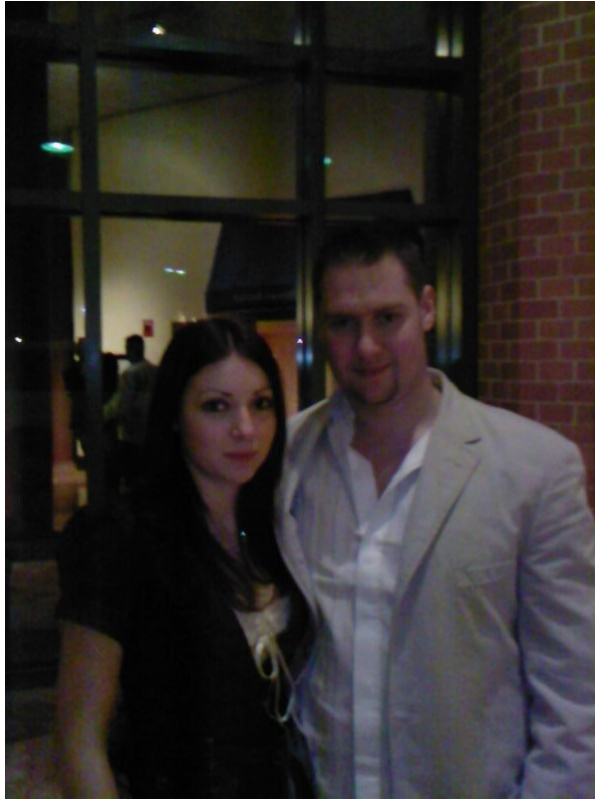

As I said earlier I get easily around 10 – 20 requests per day to promote somebodys product.


In a lot of cases the products are actually very good.
